

How to access PressReader to read online

Login with your TAFE NSW username and password (TAFE NSW account) at tafensw.libguides.com/pressreader

If you see the green coffee cup it means your login has been successful.



Scroll down to **Publications**. You can browse over 7,000 magazines and newspapers online by country, language, publication type or category.

How to Download PressReader publications to your device to read offline

To read the publications via the PressReader app, you will need to create a *PressReader account*.

- 1. Using an Internet browser to open the PressReader website: tafensw.libguides.com/pressreader
- 2. Login with your TAFE NSW account
- 3. Sign up for a PressReader account via the **Sign In** option on the PressReader homepage. Use any email address and a password of your choice to sign up (*PressReader account*).
- 4. Download the PressReader app straight from PressReader onto your preferred device/s. You can also download the app from the <u>App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>.
- 5. Authorise the app on each device by signing in with your *PressReader account* details.
- 6. Download publications for offline reading. Issues will stay on your devices until you delete them. You can schedule the removal of back issues in the settings on your device.

You can now search and download publications through the app for 30 days.

After 30 days, refresh your access by completing both steps:

- A. Signing into PressReader at <u>tafensw.libguides.com/pressreader</u> with your *TAFE NSW account* details.
- B. <u>Signing into your personal account with your *PressReader account* details via the **Sign In** option on the PressReader homepage.</u>

Troubleshooting

I do not see a statement that I have complimentary access for 30 days after logging in?

Try to access PressReader with a private browsing window. Chrome *Incognito*: (Ctrl+shift+N) Edge *InPrivate* (Ctrl+Shift+P). This will remove or ignore any cached or saved browser settings.

I'm being asked to pay for titles when I go to download them on my device.

Your access has expired. Refresh your access via your device by following steps A & B above. Note that if you are no longer enrolled, you will not be able to refresh your access.

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
