

# **Accessing the TAFE Virtual Desktop (Web Application)**

## **Purpose**

This Quick Reference Guide sets out the steps that TAFE NSW students can take to access the TAFE NSW Virtual Desktop Service (TVD).

## **Background**

TAFE NSW provides a TAFE Virtual Desktop (TVD) service for students.

#### **Before You Start**

The following elements are required before you can use the TVD.

- You must be currently enrolled at TAFE NSW
- You need to know your TAFE NSW email address, username and password
- You need to have access to a modern browser such as Chrome; Edge; Firefox; or Safari



You will be prompted to sign into your Student Microsoft Office Account.


Enter your TAFE NSW email address.

(e.g. first.lastname@studytafensw.edu.au) and your password and click **Next**.




You will be taken to the TAFE NSW Sign in Page.

Click on TAFE Student Desktop






