

Accessing TAFE NSW's Digital Services – How to Install Adobe Creative Cloud

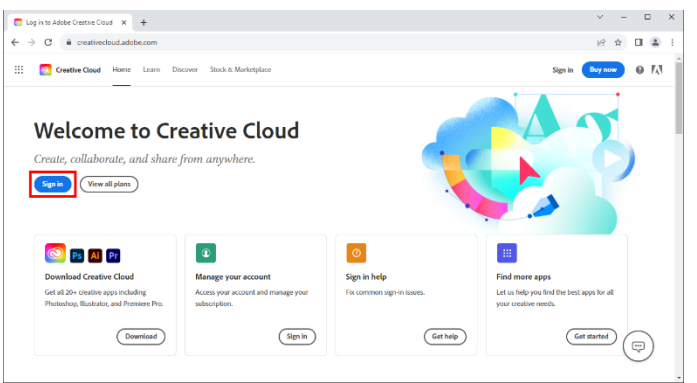
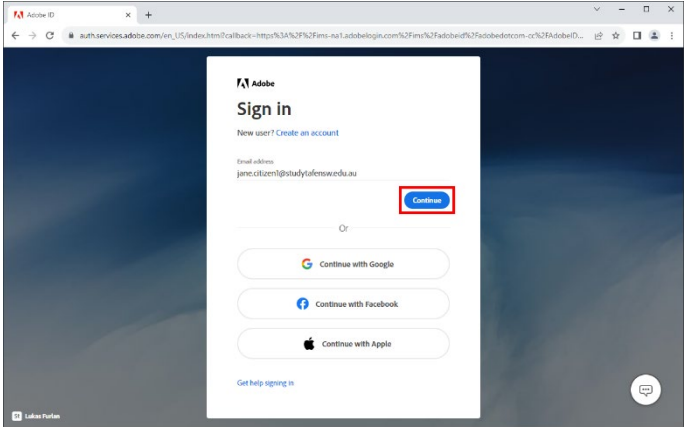
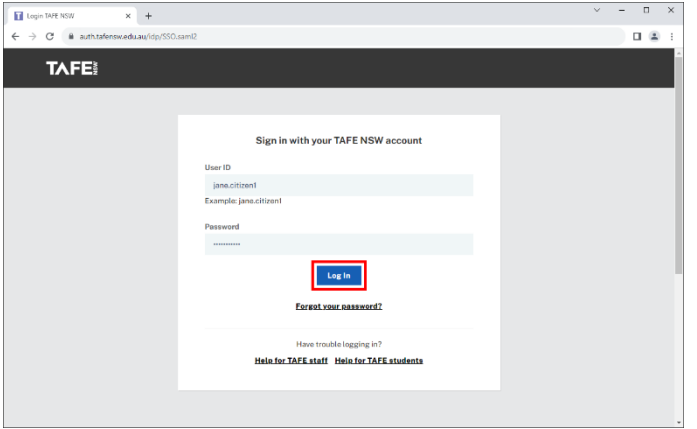
Purpose

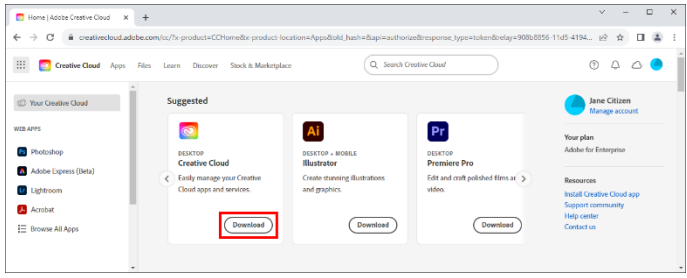
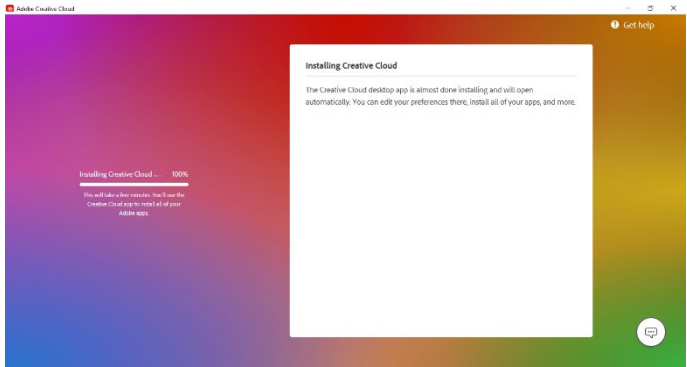
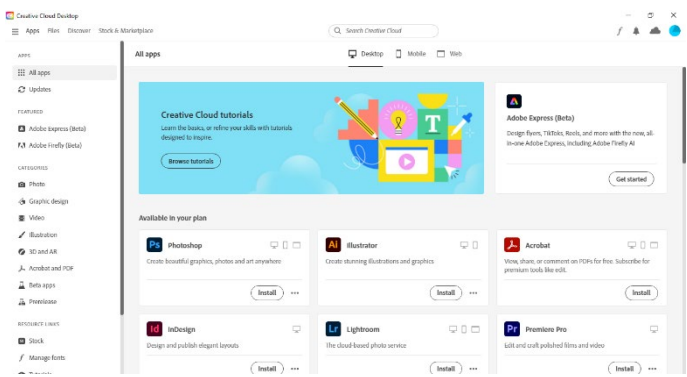
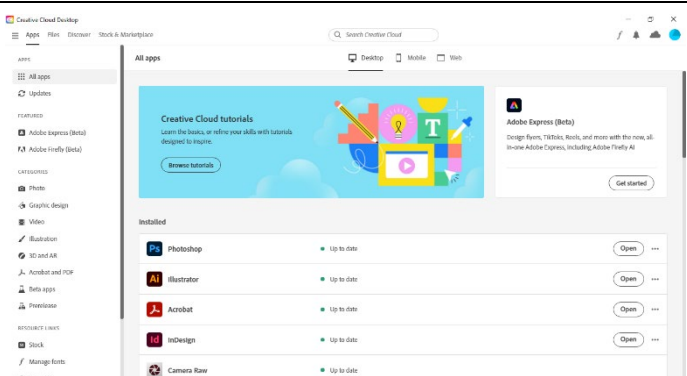
This Quick Reference Guide sets out the steps that TAFE NSW students can take to download and install the Adobe Creative Cloud onto their personal device.

Background

TAFE NSW students have access to the suite of Adobe Creative Cloud applications including Acrobat, After Effects, Animate, Illustrator, InDesign, Lightroom, Photoshop and Premiere Pro. Please note that local administrator permissions are required to install the Adobe Creative Cloud application on your device.

Accessing the Student and Learner Portal

Action	Screenshot
Open your preferred web browser and navigate to: https://creativecloud.adobe.com/ Click Sign In.	
Enter your TAFE NSW email address (e.g. jane.citizen1@studytafensw.edu.au) then click Continue.	
When prompted with the TAFE NSW portal sign in page, enter your TAFE NSW user ID (e.g. jane.citizen1) and your TAFE NSW password. Then click Log In. If prompted approve the Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) request on your device that has been previously configured for MFA.	

Action	Screenshot
Once signed into your Adobe Creative Cloud account click Download under Desktop Creative Cloud. This will commence the download. Once the download has completed, launch the file and step through the installation process.	
Allow installation to complete. Depending on your hardware and internet speed, this may take a few minutes to complete.	
When the Creative Cloud Desktop application launches, you can click Install against the application/s you want to install. Depending on your hardware and internet speed, the time taken to download and install an application may vary. Please note that due to the size of Adobe applications, data charges may apply depending on your internet connection.	
Installed application can then be launched via the Creative Cloud Desktop application, or via the Start Menu.
